Historians found a power of attorney that originated from 561BC Mesopotamia.

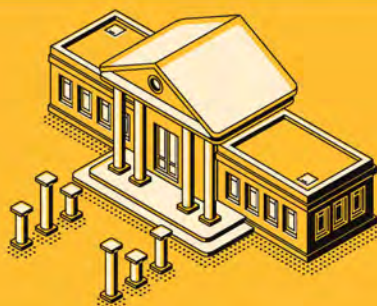


4. The Shortest Will
